What does Shelter do?

KSIII 2.3 Range and content: the voluntary sector

In Scotland: Social Studies, third and fourth level. People in society, economy and business, SOC 3-15a, SOC 3-16a, SOC 4-15a, SOC 4-16a, SOC 4-16b.

Objective:

- to learn about the work that Shelter does.

Preparation:

- download the case study cards PDF, photocopy and cut out the cards.

- On the interactive whiteboard, look at the **information on Shelter's work**. Is it what the class expected? What sort of work did they think Shelter do?

- On the interactive whiteboard, watch the film **'See how Shelter helps'**.

- Divide the class into pairs and distribute the **case study cards**. Each pair must roleplay the case study, deciding which of the three outcomes they think is most likely. A Shelter 'caseworker' is an expert adviser on housing law, the 'client' is a member of the public with a housing problem.

- On the interactive whiteboard, look at the **real results of the cases**. Are the class surprised by any of the results?
